1. EDITORIAL

With an unprecedented haul of **107 medals** that included 28 gold, 38 silver and 41 bronze medals, India set a new benchmark for themselves at the Asian Games 2023 in Hangzhou, China. It was the first time in Asian Games history that India's medals tally crossed the **three-figure** mark. Another feather in the cap was put by the Para sportspersons in the **Asian Para Games 2023** with a best-ever medal tally of **111 medals** - 29 gold, 31 silver and 51 bronze. Besides the medals the Indian Para Athletes also broke **three world records in the Javelin throw**. It's a momentous and historic achievement.

In the Guinness World Records 2023-24 - Indians have created history by making **over 60** world records in various fields.

AISV congratulates each and every sportsperson who represented our great nation at the Asian Games 2023 and special applause for the Medal Winners. **We are proud of you!**





PARENTS TEACHER MEET: 14.10.2023:



D. SCHOOL EXPANSION UPDATES
