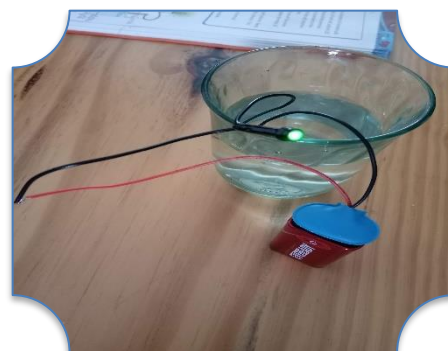
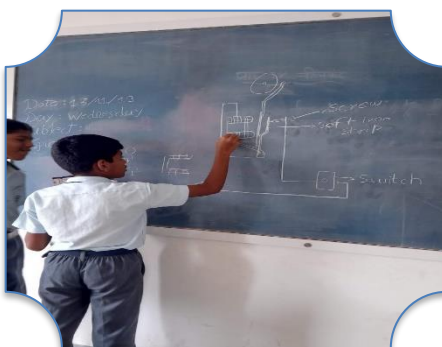


students learned about comparing the quantities. Grade 8 students enhanced their knowledge about cartesian system in Line graph.



### SCIENCE EXPLORATION: 20<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER, 2019

Students of grade 7 & 8 experienced flow of electricity in liquid, electrolysis process, electroplating and electrorefining. They explained electric circuit and working of an electric bell. Students of grade 5 came to know about air, water, atmosphere. Grade 4 students enjoyed learning about the parts of an egg, animals and their young ones, life cycle of butterfly, bird and frog. Students of grade 3 learned about various measuring techniques and equipment which were used in earlier times to measure length.



Grade 1 & 2 learned about AIR, i.e Air has weight and it also occupies space - which was unbelievable for them since at this very young age they have a belief that things do not exist if we can't see or touch them. Thus, blowing a balloon experiment was conducted in the class to show that air has weight and occupies space.



### LITERARY ELEMENTS: 28<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER, 2019

Tradition of pottery is one of the oldest crafts of India. And as Diwali is around the corner, a potter was invited to school who showed how clay is moulded into an earthen lamp and different earthen wares. Students were mesmerized to see the potter's wheel go around and round and how the potter moulded the lump of wet clay into beautiful earthen lamps, vases, glasses, piggy banks etc. Thus, the students started the preparation of the upcoming festival 'Diwali' by taking an earthen diya home as a take away gift as 'Diya signifies purity, goodness, good luck and power'.

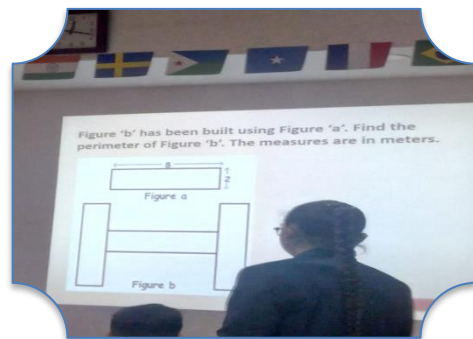

A team of dentists from Department of paediatric and Preventive Dentistry, K M Shah Dental College and Hospital, Sumandeep Vidyapeeth, Vadodara led by Dr. Seema Bargale visited our school to conduct a workshop on oral/dental health care. Information was shared about dental problems and dental care for adults and children. It was followed by an oral dental check-up.





### 3D PRINTING WORKSHOP: ROBOTICS AND FUTURE ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE: 29<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER, 2019

An interactive workshop was conducted for grade 4 to 8 students wherein Mr. Kenneth Anthony, Regional Manager of Miles Ahead pvt ltd interacted with all the students who were exposed to real life experience of getting a 3D print from the printer. They were curious to understand and experience how the printer works. The printer works by extruding molten plastic through a tiny nozzle that moves around precisely under computer control. It prints one layer, waits for it to dry, and then prints the next layer on top. The raw material used is 'corn-starch' which is Eco friendly and would not harm the environment. By the end of the session, goodies such as various miniatures of 3D animals were distributed among the students who actively participated in answering various questions asked.
