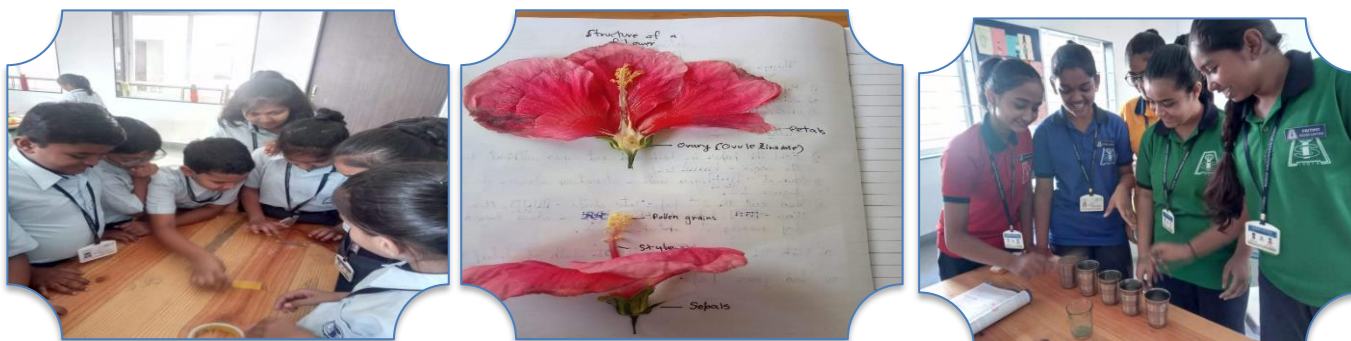
## MATHEMATICAL LOGICAL APPLICATION: 21<sup>ST</sup> TO 23<sup>RD</sup> OCTOBER, 2019
