NURSERY

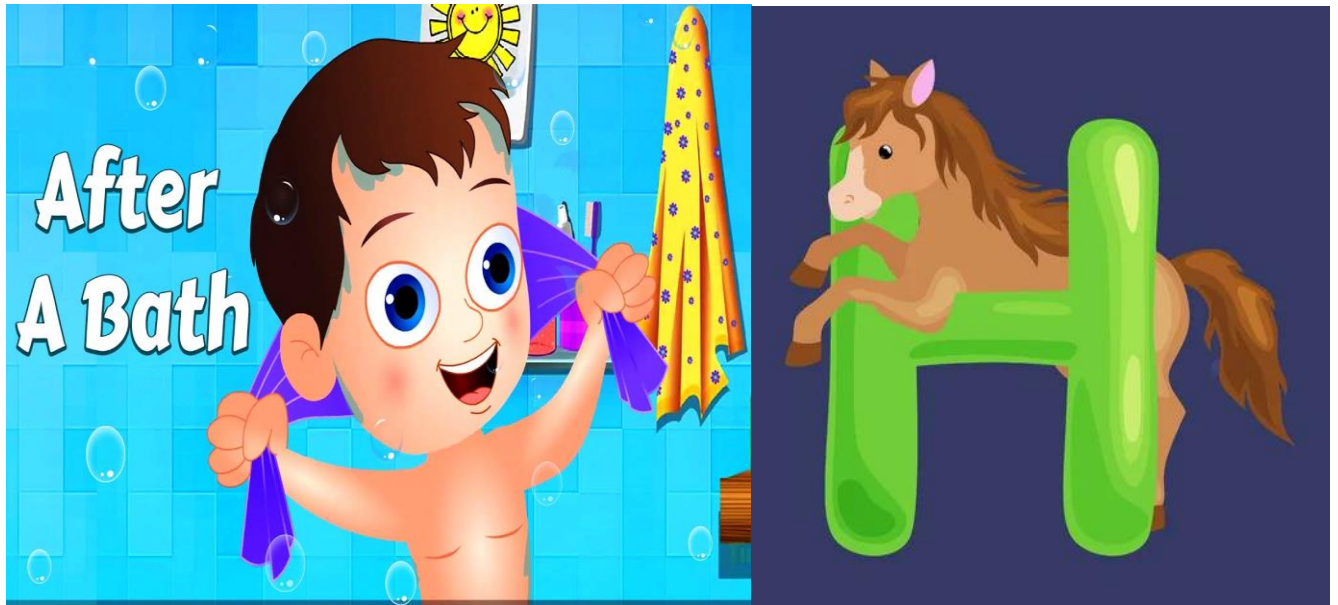
RHYMES & ORALS	Little stars revised all the rhymes done till now through actions.
