**Academic session 2022-'23** has started in offline mode and students of Grade 3 to 10 were taught the subjects English, Hindi, Mathematics, Science, Social Science and 3rd Language (Gujarati/Sanskrit). Classes of Life-skills, Gurukulam, Music, Dance, Yoga, Art and Craft were also conducted for the students.

Grade 11 students had the teaching periods of the subjects; Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics, Business Studies, Commerce, Accountancy, English and Computer

## Grade 1

SUBJECTS	STUDENTS LEARNED
