Art & Craft	Little artists coloured the triangle, oval shapes in their drawing book.

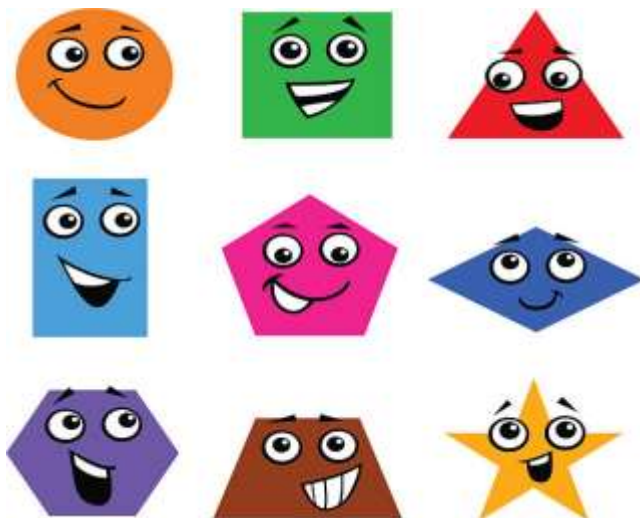
