English	Read and explain the Chapter: A Letter to God . Writing the Question and Answers is in continuation.
Mathematics	Continuing with chapter ` Real Numbers' . The concept Euclied Lemma was explained in class.
Science - Biology	The process of photosynthesis, types of autotrophs and the nutrition in Amoeba & Paramoecium were explained from the chapter ` Life processes'
Science - Physics	Continuing with the chapter, 'Light : Reflection and Refraction' , the conditions required for image formation, Ray diagrams of concave and convex mirrors for objects placed at different positions, uses of the spherical mirrors and the sign convention for spherical mirrors were explained in the class.
Social Studies- Geography	Students were made aware of the syllabus, after which a chapter in Geography, "Resources and Development"
